The Eagle County commissioners and the Eagle County Public Safety Council on Tuesday gave certificates of appreciation to 14 people who responded to the scene of a Nov. 7 fatal shooting at the Sandbar in Vail. Police officers from Vail and Avon and the Eagle County Sheriff's Office responded, as did a crew from the Eagle County Health Services District. Emergency room physicians on duty at Vail Valley Medical Center were also honored. Avon Police on Tuesday night also bestowed three members of its police force with medals of distinction for their role in responding to the Sandbar shooting. They are Lt. Greg Daly, Officer Westen Felder and Sgt. Jonathan Lovins. Avon Police also gave teamwork awards to 12 officers and two staff members for their role in diffusing a Nov. 7 situation in Wildridge, where a man barricaded himself inside a house with handguns.
